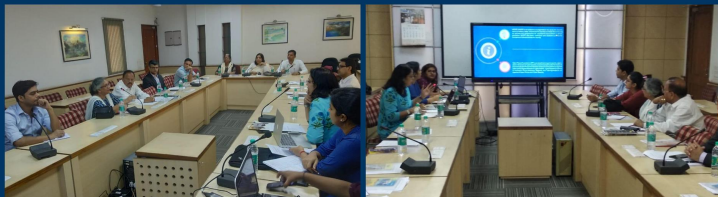




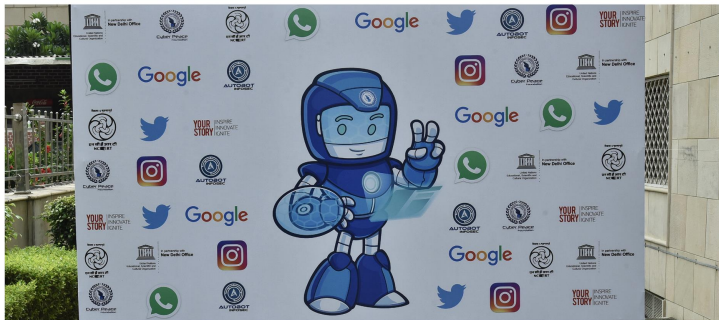
The contest was open for the private and government schools across all states of India. Besides the students, in-service teachers working in schools were also invited to participate. A separate category of Student Teachers was created to equip them as effective future leaders of this Digital World.

An overwhelming response was received with over **15000+** submissions across the length and breadth of the country, adding to the diversity and the overall vision of a completely cyber-aware India.

The winners (23) were selected after a tough task of evaluation. There were **3 rounds of assessment**. The final evaluation was done by an expert Jury across all segments connected with Cybersecurity, Law-enforcement, Wellness-Policy and Practice.

On 30th September 'Award Function of eRaksha Competition' was organized at UNESCO House, New Delhi by Cyber Peace Foundation, in partnership with UNESCO and NCERT.

The glittering and vibrant award event focused on 'Celebrating Cyber Safety and Wellness' and was attended by **more than 150 enthusiastic participants** connected with Online Safety which included policy makers, educationists, administrators, advocates, school students and most important of all, the winners and their parents who had travelled to New Delhi from remotest corners of the country.

It was an educative, inspiring and fun filled event. The quiet precinct of UNESCO was transformed into fun, vibrant and colorful arena with the sounds of excited children and even adult participants. Prior to the event and also during the break, visitors thronged around the Display Wall, admiring the creative submissions of the winners. Another group could be seen signing the Safety Pledge with due diligence. But one of the most visited and interesting corner was the Selfie Booth which excited both students and the adults.



The event began with the **launch of 'Online Safety Anthem'** of Cyber Peace Foundation followed by Awards Distribution, which was interspersed with engaging and inspiring stage activities and performances – all connected to the theme of the Award Event.

Speakers from Cyber Peace Foundation, UNESCO, NCERT, NCPCR, NDRF, Territorial Army, MEITY, YourStory and WhatsApp were very inspiring and encouraging, advising young minds to use the potential of Internet smartly and responsibly, for their growth and success.

The students and teachers were given space to share their perspective, experiences, concerns and innovativeness in dealing with the online threats and issues. The student group from 'Kulachi Hansraj School', Delhi shared inspiring initiative about 'Cyber Congress' and how they empowered not only the students and teachers from their schools but also conducted Online Safety & Responsibility Awareness Programs in the neighboring Communities for the children and parents.



The activity which stole the show, was Rap Song by a student of SR DAV school, focusing on being Safe and Responsible in the Online World.

It was a happy but emotional time for the parents of the winners who probably had never travelled outside of their state and through this competition, got a chance to visit the Capital of the country and see their children being felicitated on the large stage.

The second half of the event was more educative, a workshop was conducted for the winning students and teachers to be Cyber Safety ambassadors, championing the cause in their own cities and communities.

Media had a field day capturing the activities and also the emotions of the winners.

eRaksha 2020, with more power, will be announced shortly with the aim to extend the reach in all corners of the country.

FILED OCT 18, 2019 (UPDATED) One of the world's largest competitions in cyber safety, awareness, and cyber wellness was held from Feb 2019 to August 2019. This competition was organized by the CyberPeace Foundation in collaboration with National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) and UNESCO New Delhi Office. The aim of this initiative was to sensitize the children and youths on cyber security and get them engaged in a meaningful activity for strengthening their cyber skills in the field of digital safety, cyber wellness. This competition was organized in the context of the National Cyber Security Day (NCS Day) and was launched on 18th April 2019. The competition was held in the form of an All-India and the award ceremony was organized at UNESCO in New Delhi on 10th of September 2019. This competition was sponsored by CyberPeace and supported by India, Singapore, Thailand and Australia among others.

The contest was open to girls of all ages. Central Government, State Government and Public Schools as well as colleges and universities were invited to submit their entries. Categories of students and teachers were opened to help them an effective form of the Digital World. As a result of this competition, an award certificate was presented to the winners of each group and a commendation certificate, cash prize, trophy, certificate of appreciation.

The competition had overwhelming participation from 10 States and 7 Union Territories, adding to the diversity of the competition and the overall goal of a cyber world (Cyber Peace) table. There were 1086 girls, students from across the length and breadth of India taking part in the contest and of the winning team as Regional and the best teams in the world area in the both subject part of India. There were also award from Russia and UAE.

The award was collected after a long process of rigorous evaluation. There were three rounds of assessment before deciding the Region. The final evaluation was done by a committee of experts who were consisted of cyber security, government, industry, law, science, and non-governmental organisations (NGOs, IEDS). The award for the contest was to be given to the best team in each category.

An interesting feature of this competition was that participants were given cyber safety and cyber wellness certificate, besides the competition certificate and trophies.
